and who is behind it. Usually, in these sorts of cases the person concerned

has a theory. Others might ridicule them and call it a "conspiracy theory"

but at least the person concerned can put a structure to their circumstances. I don't see that here, nor do I believe that the unfortunate

plagiarisation of his thesis would have been sufficient to trigger off the

sequence of disjointed and negative events that have occurred over a long period of time.

While reading through the first part of the attachment the possibility of this gentleman having accidentally tripped over some sort of intelligence

operation came to mind, but then I tended to discount that. Mention of

Freemasons made things even murkier. I doubt that that would explain very much.

Overall, there must clearly be a reason why he has been blacklisted in more recent times, but I cannot figure out what it might be from the attachment alone. Have you met the bloke himself? What was your assessment?

If you think there is some way I might be able to help please don't hesitate to let me know. I never dismiss cases like this out of hand. Too often the surface details are dysfunctional and yet when the truth is finally exposed you can see how it was hidden in behind the story.

In the meantime, I will delete the file.
